*Prayer of the Wounded Warrior Woman by Rita Cromwell (Cherokee-Coushatta-Caddo) Written 5/19/97*

You have taken my home. You have taken my family. You have tried to take my life too.

My body is a sacred place you try to defile with your deceit and your hate. A woman's body is always in a state of self-cleansing like a rain that washes the sand from the rocks.

They have tried to conquer me but they don't know my heart-or my utter contempt for their cowardice.

Only a fool would thin that physical force would make me love you! You are hate. You are violence. It is you who fear or you would not try to overcome me. God forgive you for what you have done to my children. Your greed pales beside their innocence. Our power is greater than yours.

Yours wilts in the grass when the sun shines. Ours grows and grows with time. I give life and you take it. You are everything I hate and everything I despise.

One day I will walk on your grave... and the birds will laugh. \* The bear will use the bones of your legs to clean his teeth. The coyote wins your soul. I will walk on. The violence of the living becomes the desolation of the dead. I will pass you like clouds of dust from horses' hooves and you will never touch me again.

\* Symbols in Native American culture: bear is strength. The coyote is usually the trickster that tried to get the best of a situation. Birds are in the air and see what was done to this person.
